Timeline

PARTICIPATION NUMBERS

- ▣ Middle School – Approximately 400
- ▣ High School – Approximately 600
 - Test all one time in August
 - Test 10% on Random test September - May

PROPOSED TESTING

- ▣ 1 Total Sample Test in August
- ▣ Monthly Random Testing (Sept – May)
- ▣ Random Sample Selected by Testing Company
- ▣ Test 10% of the total sample approximately 60 students

PENALTY STRUCTURE

- ▣ 1st Offense
 - Counseling – Campus counselor (twice during the 14 day suspension)
 - Monthly Testing (12 calendar months)
 - 14 calendar day suspension from competition and driving on campus

 - ▣ 2nd Offense
 - Counseling – Campus counselor (once a week during the 90 day suspension)
 - ▣ Complete a 4 hour video on awareness – (\$25 to parents)
 - Monthly Testing (12 calendar months)
 - 90 calendar day suspension from competition and driving on campus

 - ▣ 3rd Offense
 - Counseling – At a counselor of the parents choosing and expense. They must submit documentation of 12 hours of counseling over the 1 year suspension
 - Monthly Testing (12 calendar months)
 - 1 year suspension from competition and driving on campus

 - ▣ 4th Offense
 - No further participation in extra-curricular activities / driving for the remainder of their Sanger ISD career
- * SUSPENSIONS ARE BASED ON CALENDAR DAYS IN THE SCHOOL YEAR*
- *(Days are not counted over the summer or during the 5 day UIL break in December)*

Procedural Items

- ❑ Students will follow testing procedures. They will be notified by an administrator, leave their cell phones and back packs in a secure location on campus and be transported to Indian Gym for testing
- ❑ Students will have a 3 hour window to provide a sample. If they do not produce a sample in that time it is considered a procedure positive and the will enter the protocol for a positive test
- ❑ Upon notification of a positive test the parent and student will meet with the District testing coordinator within 48 hours. Suspension will begin after the parent meeting or conclusion of the 48 hour time window.
- ❑ Those found in possession on campus or issued a ticket for possession off campus will follow the same penalty structure.
- ❑ A student who refuses to test will be considered to have a positive test and enter the protocol for a positive test.
