

SANGER ISD PROPOSED PROJECTS

- **Address major maintenance, A/C and roof needs** **\$4,900,000**
District wide repairs based upon facility needs assessment.

- **Increase academic capacity at high school** **\$7,000,000**
The increased capacity will alleviate overcrowding in our High School environment. The increase will also help accommodate the addition of new CTE programs at the high school. The new programs, having been voiced by students and faculty as valuable programs, include Health Occupations, Culinary Arts, Vocational, and Fabrication.

- **Provide improved agricultural facilities** **\$3,620,000**
The new facilities will provide more opportunity for students to keep projects on site and add convenience for teachers to teach on-site and will also include an Instructional Teaching Lab. The new lab will improve learning in Agricultural Sciences.

- **Provide additional paved parking to support band** **\$ 60,000**
The new addition will be separate from the main parking area that band students are currently using for practice. High traffic times throughout school days will not effect the bands ability to practice marching. The proximity to the band hall is still very accessible.

- **Relocate football program to the stadium to free up space to support continued growth in the girls' athletics programs** **\$4,700,000**
The relocation of the boys' program will provide the girls' programs adequate space. Additionally, it will improve student safety and security within both the boys' and girls' programs. The relocation also includes a new training room closer to outside sports, as well as provides additional space and resources necessary to accommodate our student athletic training program.

- **Reconfigure existing athletics locker rooms** **\$ 400,000**
The reconfiguration provides additional space and security needed by the girls' programs to accommodate athletic bags, school bags, electronic devices, etc. It will also provide more electrical outlets and more seating in areas that will increase student mobility and safety. In this reconfiguration, the area outside the existing weight room will be enclosed to allow for additional storage for the girls' programs. The additional space (currently used by the girls' programs) will provide band with additional storage.

- **Provide stadium improvements to support spectator activities** **\$2,800,000**
These improvements will include a noticeable point of entry into the stadium. Also included are relocation of the restrooms, as well as relocating and expanding the concession stand.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <p>▪ Provide artificial turf at baseball and softball fields \$1,750,000</p> <p><i>Current fields can flood during adverse weather conditions. These fields require recurring maintenance expenditures on an annual basis (such as water use, fertilizer, mowing, etc.) that can be eliminated by going to artificial surfaces. In the past, we have also paid other districts for the use of their facilities because of a large number of consecutive adverse weather events impacted the entire District's athletic schedule.</i></p> <p>▪ Provide improvements to Sanger Middle School \$1,530,000</p> <p><i>Sanger Middle School has adequate student capacity though the 2025 school year based on district enrollment projections conducted in the Fall of 2016. Repairs will be made to the roof, restrooms, lighting, and exterior.</i></p> 	<p>TOTAL \$26,760,000</p>
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Additional \$5 million for this Bond Program has been allocated by the Sanger ISD Board of Trustees out of local fund balance to minimize impact on debt tax rate.
